
Section 38-567-604. Yard Sales.

- 1) Residents wishing to hold a yard sale must first obtain a permit from the City of Prattville. A small issuance fee shall be charged for the permit. Only three permits within a calendar year shall be issued to the citizen and no such permit shall be issued for more than three consecutive calendar days.
- 2) Members of more than one residence may join in requesting a permit, but only one permit shall be paid. Each household included in the permit shall be treated as having conducted a yard sale.
- 3) All yard sales must be conducted on the premises where the applicant resides, excepting churches and non-profit organizations, which are exempt from the fee, but still require a permit.
- 4) Signs advertising yard sales must not be placed on rights of ways, utility poles, street or traffic signs.
- 5) Yard sales held at a business location must have written approval from the business/property owner at the time of issuance of yard sale permit.
