
Sec. 54-3. Obstructions—Generally.

It shall be unlawful for any person to place goods, wares, merchandise, fruits, vegetables, boxes, barrels, containers, dispensers, signs or any other obstruction of any kind in or upon any street, avenue, alley or sidewalk within the city. It shall likewise be unlawful for any person in charge of or occupying any property to permit goods, wares, merchandise, boxes, barrels, containers, dispensers, signs or other obstructions to remain on the street, alley, avenue or sidewalk adjoining the property or building in such person's charge or control, whether the same was placed thereon by such person or not.
